Note: **The Holy Spirit and Baptism.** The word baptism carries the dual meaning of "Immersing" and "Merging", as when a garment is placed in liquid dye. The moment a person trusts Christ and is born again, he/she receives a two-fold **spiritual baptism**: First, we are baptized by Christ with the Holy Spirit (see Matt. 3:11, Mk. 1:8, Lk. 3:16). Secondly, the Spirit baptizes us into the Body of Christ, vitally relating us to Christ and to all other Christians (see Rom. 6:1-10, and 1 Cor. 12-13). The public ritual of **water baptism** is properly understood to be a beautiful outward symbol and testimony of this inner spiritual reality.
